

# – Cloud Voice Simultaneous ringing

## 1 What is it?

You can set up to 10 phone numbers to ring at the same time that your main phone rings whenever you get a call.

Calls have to match a set of criteria that you set before they set off a simultaneous ring: a list of up to 10 numbers, a time or holiday schedule, and day of week and time of day.

If the criteria do not match, the call continues as if this service wasn't on.

# 2 How do I set it up?

There are three options

#### **Option 1**

- 1. Login to the <u>BT Cloud Voice portal</u>
- 2. Select Employees
- 3. Select Dashboard
- 4. Switch Sim Ring on or off using the slider

7. Turn on 'Simultaneous Ring'

- 8. Check the appropriate option in 'Settings'
- 9. To add a phone number enter it and click 'Add'
- 10. Select 'Answer Confirmation Required' (if it is ...)
- 11. To delete a number select the right hand tick box next to the entry and click **'Delete'**
- 12. To delete all numbers select the right hand tick box in the header bar and click 'Delete'
