Connecting Manchester to make smarter decisions

How our Internet of Things hub became central to the CityVerve smart city

Can the Internet of Things (IoT) make Manchester a better place to live and work? As part of the CityVerse initiative, we joined forces with the city council, local universities, and other tech companies to find out.

At the heart of this large-scale project is the need to do more with data. And that job came down to us. We created a hub collecting 200 datasets in one place, from Met Office weather observations to automatic traffic counts.

This data gives the council a unique understanding of how services are being used. This allows them to make smarter decisions about how to invest resources. It's helping improve healthcare, and make Manchester's streets and transport safer.

CityVerve provides a blueprint for how to roll out smart city programmes, both across the North and worldwide.
