# **Data Processing Annex**

### 1 Subject Matter Of The Processing Of Personal Data

This Data Processing Annex sets out the details regarding how Customer Personal Data is Processed when providing the EE Mobile Service.

#### 2 Duration Of The Processing Of Personal Data

EE or its Sub-Processor will Process the Customer Personal Data for the EE Mobile Service as set out in this Annex for as long as BT provides the EE Mobile Service and for as long as BT may be required to Process the Customer Personal Data in accordance with Applicable Law.

## 3 The Nature And Purpose Of The Processing Of Personal Data

- 3.1 The EE Mobile Service provides you with a mobile wireless communications Service.
- 3.2 EE Processes any information that is generated by your use (or your employees', agents' or sub-contractors' use) of voice mail, voice recording, text messaging features and web browsing. Given that recordings can be made and stored, any type of Personal Data could be captured or provided inadvertently by the end User. Any access to the content of such communications by EE is strictly in accordance with Applicable Law.

## 4 Types Of Personal Data and Categories of Data Subjects

- 4.1 The types of Customer Personal Data Processed by BT or its Sub-Processors or you may be:
  - 4.1.1 name;
  - 4.1.2 gender:
  - 4.1.3 date of birth;
  - 4.1.4 email address;
  - 4.1.5 address;
  - 4.1.6 telephone number;
  - 4.1.7 associated persons;
  - 4.1.8 contact notes from calls;
  - 4.1.9 contact records;
  - 4.1.10 family and friends telephone numbers;
  - 4.1.11 Personal Data traffic and communications records; and
  - 4.1.12 recordings, including mobile voice and text message.

This list is not exhaustive as you will specify what Customer Personal Data is Processed.

- 4.2 The Customer Personal Data may concern the following categories of Data Subjects:
  - 4.2.1 your end Users;
  - 4.2.2 third party participants in voice calls or text messages to and from your end Users; and
  - 4.2.3 your employees, directors and contractors.

This list is not exhaustive as you will specify what Customer Personal Data is Processed.
