1 Subject Matter Of The Processing Of Personal Data

This Data Processing Annex sets out the details regarding how Customer Personal Data is Processed when providing the Private Compute Data Centre Services.

2 Duration Of The Processing Of Personal Data

BT or its Sub-Processor will Process the Customer Personal Data for the Private Compute Data Centre Services as set out in this Annex for as long as BT provides the Private Compute Data Centre Services and for as long as BT may be required to Process the Customer Personal Data in accordance with Applicable Law.

3 The Nature And Purpose Of The Processing Of Personal Data

- 3.1 The Private Compute Data Centre Services provide you with hardware and software provision services. BT provides support services to maintain the hardware environment but you are responsible for the operating system, applications and data stored and/or utilised.
- 3.2 BT Processes (hosts) any information that you (or your employees, agents or subcontractors) upload. BT has no control or oversight of the nature of the data this is being stored on its servers, or the purpose that you are fulfilling in such storage.

4 Types Of Personal Data and Categories of Data Subjects

- 4.1 The types of Customer Personal Data Processed by BT or its Sub-Processors or you may be:
 - 4.1.1 website or IP address;
 - 4.1.2 name;
 - 4.1.3 address:
 - 4.1.4 telephone number;
 - 4.1.5 email address;
 - 4.1.6 job title;
 - 4.1.7 company name; and
 - 4.1.8 contact records.

- 4.2 The Customer Personal Data may concern the following categories of Data Subjects:
 - 4.2.1 your employees; and
 - 4.2.2 your customers or third parties.
