# 1 Subject Matter Of The Processing Of Personal Data

This Data Processing Annex sets out the details regarding how Customer Personal Data is Processed when providing the Redcare Classic, Redline and GSM Services.

#### 2 Duration Of The Processing Of Personal Data

BT or its Sub-Processor will Process the Customer Personal Data for the Redcare Classic, Redline and GSM Services as set out in this Annex for as long as BT provides the Redcare Classic, Redline and GSM Services and for as long as BT may be required to Process the Customer Personal Data in accordance with Applicable Law.

### 3 The Nature And Purpose Of The Processing Of Personal Data

- 3.1 The nature and purpose of the Processing of Customer Personal Data by BT includes:
  - 3.1.1 to facilitate the fulfilment of BT's obligations under the Redcare Classic, Redline and GSM Services Schedule, including:
    - 3.1.1.1 implementing all or any of the Service Options for the Redcare Classic, Redline and GSM Services;
    - 3.1.1.2 managing, tracking and resolving Incidents associated with the Redcare Classic, Redline and GSM Services; and
    - 3.1.1.3 administering access to online portals relating to the Redcare Classic, Redline and GSM Services.

#### 4 Types Of Personal Data and Categories of Data Subjects

- 4.1 The types of Customer Personal Data Processed by BT or its Sub-Processors or you will be:
  - 4.1.1 name;
  - 4.1.2 e-mail address;
  - 4.1.3 postal address;
  - 4.1.4 contact number;
  - 4.1.5 user IDs or login credentials;
  - 4.1.6 passwords;
  - 4.1.7 IP Addresses;
- 4.2 The Customer Personal Data will concern the following categories of Data Subjects:
  - 4.2.1 your Installers;
  - 4.2.2 End Customers; and
  - 4.2.3 your employees, directors and contractors.
