1 Subject Matter Of The Processing Of Personal Data

This Data Processing Annex sets out the details regarding how Customer Personal Data is Processed when providing the Ethernet Multi-Service Interconnect Links Service.

2 Duration Of The Processing Of Personal Data

BT or its Sub-Processor will Process the Customer Personal Data for the Ethernet Multi-Service Interconnect Links Service as set out in this Annex for as long as BT provides the Ethernet Multi-Service Interconnect Links Service and for as long as BT may be required to Process the Customer Personal Data in accordance with Applicable Law.

3 The Nature And Purpose Of The Processing Of Personal Data

- 3.1 BT Provide a connectivity product which allows Communication Providers to interconnect into our national broadband products. This interconnect product is a dumb pipe which simply transfers data traffic between the CPs network and the BT broadband network.
- 3.2 BT maintain personal contact information for the technical contacts with the CPs but no end user account or end user customer information is processed.
