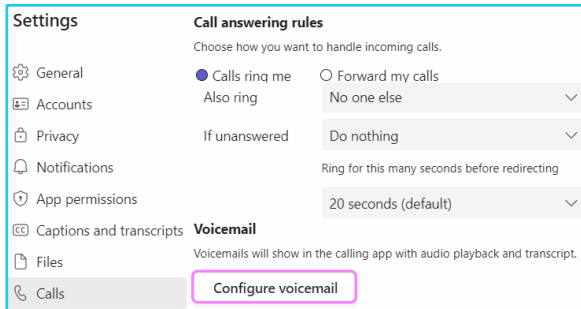


Teams allows you to setup your voicemail for when you are not available. There are various options available and you can set this up according to your preferences.

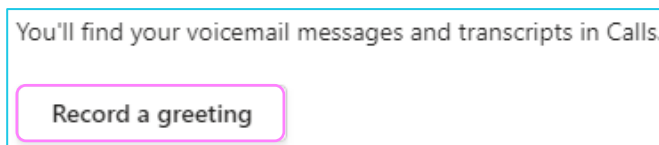
Setup your voicemail

1. Click **Settings and more** > **Settings** > **Calls** > **Configure voicemail**.



Record a personal greeting

1. Click **Record a greeting** and follow the prompts to save, re-record or delete the message.

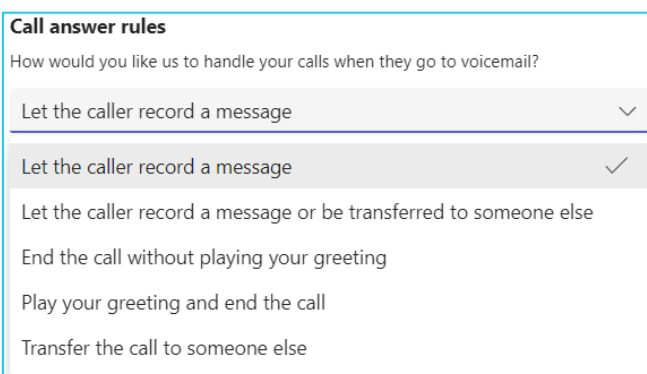


Call answer rules

1. You can choose how calls are handled when they go to voicemail.

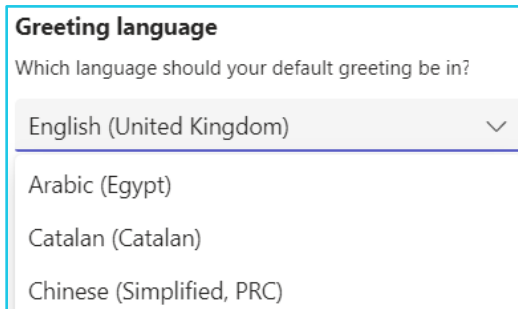
From the drop-down menu choose a suitable answer rule:

- Let the caller record a message
- Let the caller record a message or be transferred to someone else
- End the call without playing your greeting
- Play your greeting and end the call
- Transfer the call to someone else.

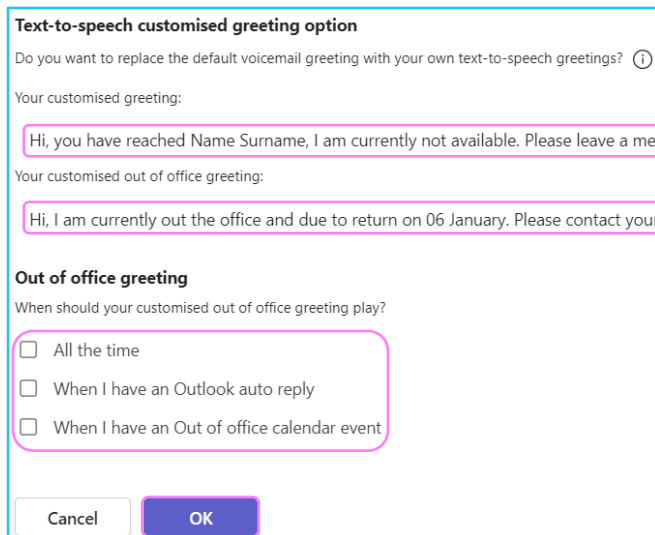

Text-to-speech customised greeting

1. You can add a custom text-to-speech message for your standard voicemail as well as an Out of office greeting.
2. Type a message in the relevant field.
3. For the Out of office greeting you can choose when the greeting should play.
