## 1 Words defined in the General Terms

Words that are capitalised but have not been defined in this Annex have the meanings given to them in the General Terms or the BT Business Broadband Schedule.

## 2 This Annex

- 2.1 The terms of this Annex apply where you have ordered a new Broadband Service and have been informed by BT that Next Day Connection is included with your Broadband Service at no additional Charge and these terms are in addition to the General Terms and the BT Business Broadband Schedule.
- 2.2 If your Broadband Service is terminated, for whatever reason, the Next Day Connection service will automatically terminate.

## 3 Next Day Connection

- 3.1 If you place an Order for Broadband Essential or Superfast Essential BT will notify you if you are also eligible for Next Day Connection.
- 3.2 Where you choose to receive Next Day Connection BT will provide you with a NDC 4G Dongle and NDC Docking Station.
- 3.3 BT will aim to send out the NDC 4G Dongle and NDC Docking Station using next day delivery once you have placed your Order with BT however all timescales are estimates and BT is not responsible where delivery takes longer than this.
- 3.4 Once you have received your NDC 4G Dongle you can use it to receive Next Day Connection until your Access Line has been provisioned.

## 4 Your Obligations

- 4.1 Before the Service Start Date and, where applicable, throughout the provision of the Broadband Service by BT, you will, in respect of Next Day Connection:
  - 4.1.1 install a compatible BT Hub in accordance with any instructions BT provides;
  - 4.1.2 plug the NDC 4G Dongle into the NDC Docking Station which connects to the BT Hub;
  - 4.1.3 only use the Sim Card with the NDC 4G Dongle; and
  - 4.1.4 only use Next Day Connection in the period before BT confirms to you that your Broadband Service is ready for use.

## 5 Acceptable Use

- 5.1 In addition to any rights BT may have under Clause 18 of the General Terms, if you use Next Day Connection in breach of Paragraphs 4.1.3 or 4.1.4 of this Annex or Clauses 6.6 and 12.3 of the General Terms, BT may, without notice:
  - (a) terminate Next Day Connection; or
  - (b) temporarily or permanently block the SIM Card used with Next Day Connection.

## 6 Definitions

In addition to the defined terms in the General Terms and the BT Business Broadband Schedule, capitalised terms in this Annex will have the following meanings (and in the case of conflict between these defined terms and the defined terms in the General Terms and the BT Business Broadband Schedule, these defined terms will take precedence for the purposes of this Annex):

**"Next Day Connection"** or **"NDC"** means connection to the Internet over the BT 4G network using an NDC 4G Dongle prior to provision of the Broadband Service using an Access Line.

**"NDC 4G Dongle"** means a device that is plugged into your BT Hub using the NDC Docking Station and that will provide you with Next Day Connection and is Purchased Equipment for the purposes of this Annex.

**"NDC Docking Station"** means a device to be used with Next Day Connection, including a power lead, in which a laptop computer, smartphone, or other mobile device may be placed for charging, providing access to a power supply and to peripheral devices or auxiliary features, and is classed as Purchased Equipment for the purposes of this Annex.
